We are happy to invite you to the 2017 VdGM|AMFCluj Conference Exchange, which will be held in Cluj-Napoca (Romania) between May 7th-13th!

Participants will observe Romanian family doctors in their practices during the first 2 days of the exchange and are invited to attend the Cluj County's Family Doctors' Association (AMF Cluj) Conference between 10-13 May.

There will be an English spoken session at the Conference, as well as a session for young doctors.

Timetable:

- We expect you to arrive in Cluj on Sunday 7th of May. Book your flight back home for Saturday 13th of May.
- Monday and Tuesday you will visit family doctors offices from the city and from the country side.
- Wednesday - VdGM session - you will prepare a short presentation about family medicine in your country, about the way students and young trainees feel about family medicine and the difficulties you encountered in your training years. . You will have the rest of the day free to explore the city.
- Wednesday, Thursday and Friday - Conference sessions
- Friday evening - Special Dinner (you are not allowed to skip it) :P
